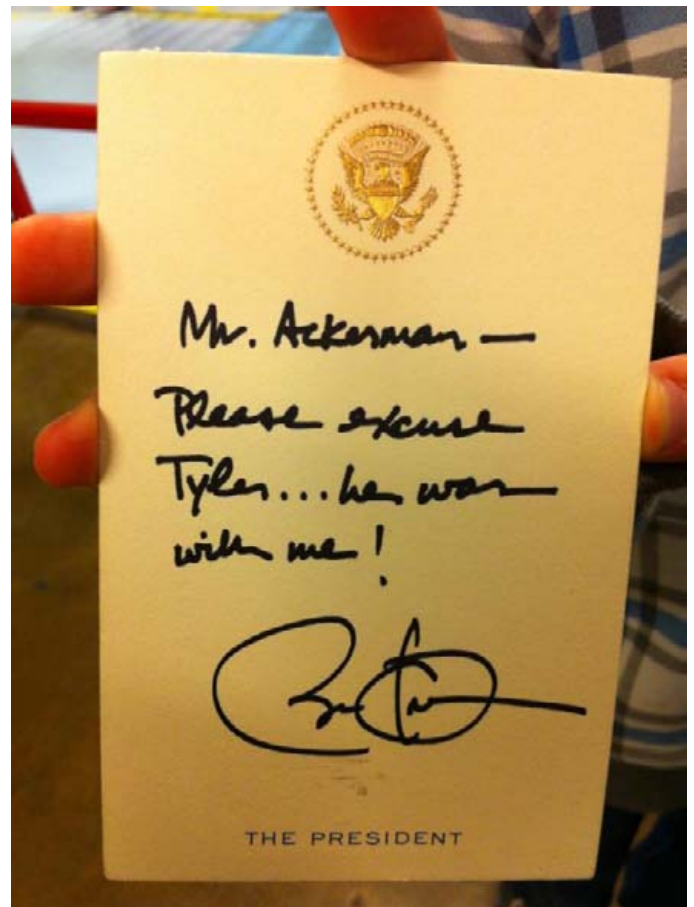


## President Obama Writes Absence Note For Fifth Grader In Minnesota
